Ask Engineering

I see a 4 digit code on the print string. What does that signify? Also, how accurate are the foot markers?

The 4 digit code on TLC's print string is actually the Date of Manufacture, in Julian Date format. The first of the 4 digit code is the year of manufacture (last digit of the year) and the final 3 digits is the day of the year. Example: 2068 = The 68th day of 2022.

The frequency of print strings on TLC's standard cable is one print string every 2 feet with a tolerance of +1/8" / -0.0". UL standards require print spacing be no longer than 40" (1 meter) apart. On a reel, industry standard GR-409 states that the accuracy of the length marking is required to be within +1%/-0%, with the cable always actually being longer than the length marks indicate.
